SUBJECT: Further Reduction in the Syllabus of Selected Subjects for the ICSE and ISC Year 2021 Examinations

Dear Principal,

This is further to my letter dated 3rd July 2020 regarding reduction of Syllabi at the ICSE & ISC levels for the current academic year (2020-21) and the Examination Year 2021.

In view of the continuing pandemic situation and significant loss of instructional hours during this academic year, and based on the findings of the online survey conducted by CISCE on the **Status of Online Teaching** and the **Extent of Syllabus Covered** in its affiliated schools, it has been decided to make further reductions in selected Syllabi at the **ICSE** and **ISC** levels for the Examination Year 2021 (i.e. for Classes X and XII).

The **Further Reduced Syllabi** for the ICSE (Class X) and ISC (Class XII) Year 2021 Examinations are available on the CISCE website www.cisce.org under **PUBLICATIONS**. Please note that the reduction in the ICSE and ISC Syllabi for the Examination Year 2021 (for Classes X and XII) has been carried out in **two** stages, with the first round of reductions being carried out in July 2020 and further reduction in selected subjects being done now, in September.

In this regard, please find attached the Lists of Subjects being offered for the ICSE and ISC Year 2021 Examinations. For each of the subjects included in the ICSE/ISC lists, it is specified whether the syllabus for the subject was **REDUCED** (in July) or **FURTHER REDUCED** (in September). Subjects in which no changes have been made are marked as **NOT REDUCED**.

Further, please note that the Project Work already completed by students in different subject/s, on topics which have later been removed from the Syllabus, is to be accepted and marked.

This is for your kind information. You are required to inform all the concerned students and teachers accordingly.
